YAP STATE LAW NO. 11-116

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2025

AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-80, as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-104 and 11-107, by further amending the Title and Section 1, as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-104 and 11-107, for the purpose of appropriating an additional sum of \$374,559 from the General Fund for funding certain government operations during Fiscal Year 2025, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-80, as
2 amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-104 and 11-107, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "To appropriate the sum of \$11,183,813 from the Yap
5 State Fiscal Year 2025 financial estimates in Yap
6 State Treasury for the purpose of funding government
7 operations, programs and projects in the State of Yap
8 during Fiscal Year 2025, and for other purposes."

9 Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-80, as
10 amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-104 and 11-107, is hereby
11 further amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 1. Operations, Programs and Projects. The
13 sum of \$11,183,813, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
14 is hereby appropriated from the State Treasury for the
15 purpose of funding government operations, programs and
16 projects during Fiscal Year 2025. The sum appropriated

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1 shall be \$11,183,813 from the General Fund of the State
2 of Yap from Local Revenues for \$9,377,670, from Program
3 Income for \$739,002, from Airport and Airway Operation and
4 Maintenance Account for \$125,061, and from the General Fund
5 Tobacco Tax account for \$942,080; and shall be apportioned
6 in accordance with the following schedule:
