A RESOLUTION

Expressing the Thirteenth Kosrae State Legislature’s profound gratitude and sincere appreciations to certain individuals/ entities from Honolulu, Hawaii, for their generous donations and humanitarian support to the people and the State of Kosrae.

1 **WHEREAS**, this humanitarian aid effort was led by Kosrae’s very own Mrs. Shanty
2 Sigrah Asher, who partnered with the Habel Organization of Hawaii and the Kosrae
3 Community Organization in Honolulu (KOCHO), bringing this initiative to fruition; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the State Government of Kosrae, formally represented by Acting Governor
5 Arthy G. Nena, DOE Director Tulensru Waguk, and DHS Acting Director Shiro Sigrah,
6 officially received this generous donation on the 2nd of July, 2025, by way of a forty-foot
7 container filled with home and work supplies, which was then physically handed-over by Mrs.
8 Shanty and Mr. Joseph “Kimchee” Isisaki, on behalf of the Kosrae Organization in Hawaii; and

9 **WHEREAS**, this humanitarian aid effort, as shared by the chaperons, could not have
10 been made possible without the collaboration and immense support of certain individuals/
11 entities, which included the following: Matson Shipping, who sponsored the shipping and all
12 shipping costs; Project Vision, who served as the local fiscal sponsor and the largest donor of
13 hospital equipment and supplies; Hawaii State Senator, The Honorable Glenn Wakai, who
14 helped secure key donors such as Home Depot (who donated new appliances -- 2 refrigerators, 2
15 washers, and 2 dryers); The Agan Family, who provided a pallet filled with sports equipment for

17 kitchen supplies for the hospital; Kamehameha Schools, which donated 80 boxes of books;


